PARENT AND SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Morialta Uniting Church Netball Club endorses the following code of conduct for all parents and spectators within our club.

Parents and Spectators will:

- *Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.*
- *Encourage children to participate, do not force them.*
- *Focus on the child's and the team's efforts and performance rather than winning and losing.*
- *Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.*
- *Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.*
- *Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good plays by all teams.*
- *Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.*
- *Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.*
- *Offer assistance at training and matches, but do not interfere with the coach's direction of the team. Wait until after training/match to speak with your child and give them "your advice."*
- *Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.*
