PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Morialta Uniting Church Netball Club endorses the following code of conduct for all players within our club.

Players will:

- Play by the rules, fairly and safely.
- Always respect the decision of the umpires.
- Conduct yourself in a responsible manner regarding language and temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain approach the official during a break or after the competition.
- Work equally hard, at training and at games, for yourself and/or your team, as your team's performance will benefit, so will you.
- Take training sessions seriously, as this is where you learn and improve your skills.
- Be honest with your coach concerning illness and injury, and your ability to play and train.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all players, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Respect & co-operate with your coach, umpire, teammates and opponents, as without them there would be no competition.
- Play for the fun of it, and not just to please parents and coaches.
