

# Morialta Uniting Church Netball Club

## Court Time Policy

At all levels the 'enjoyment' of the sport of netball is paramount. The club's aim is to develop all players and provide a solid base of skills that will hold them in good stead for as long as they wish to play netball.

### During minor round matches

- Where practical, players will be rotated evenly on court throughout the minor round, taking into account factors such as availability, training attendance, sportsmanship, attitude and injury.
- Players that regularly do not attend training may not be considered for court time if sufficient players are available.

### During major round matches

- Unfinancial players are NOT eligible to participate in major round games unless numbers dictate an exception which must be approved by the committee.
- The combination of selected team members that would result in the best chance for success will be played at the coach's discretion.
- In age grade teams (17 years and under or below) coaches will endeavour to play all players for a minimum of 2 quarters taking into account factors such as availability during the season, training attendance, sportsmanship, attitude and injury.
- Fill-in players - when players from the selected team members are not available and extra players are required to fill seven positions on court, these fill-in players may play a full game which is equivalent to selected team members.
- Fill-in players (additional to the selected team members) are not required to take the court but if they do (depending on positional rotations) should not receive more court time than selected team members. An exception will be allowed if players are not available for positional rotation, for example, if only two (2) goalers are available and one (1) of the goalers is a fill-in player, they will be allowed to play the full game.
